CBP Reporting Offsite Arrival – Mobile (ROAM) app

The CBP ROAM app is a free mobile application that provides a new and faster option for pleasure boaters to report their U.S. entry to CBP. Travelers can use their personal smart device (or a tablet located at partner businesses) to satisfy reporting requirements in select areas. All travelers, regardless of nationality or citizenship, are eligible to use the CBP ROAM app. Read more in attachment listed at end of my newsletter.

2018 Poker Runs

***June 15-16:** Cooley Canal Yacht Club

1. If you are planning to be at Cooley Canal on Friday night, June 15th, and want to support our Commodore in the \$1.98 contest at Toledo Sailing Club, there is a bus available for \$20 each and \$1-2 service fee.

2. If you are attending this Poker Run via boat, boats can be kept at Cooley Canal until the following weekend and captain them to Harbor View for their poker run. See Fleet Captain Teri Upholzer if you are planning to attend via boat so she can assist in making arrangements.
3. ***Keeping your boat at Cooley Canal all week allows for 1 trip south to attend 2 Poker Runs!**
4. Let's get SSBC's name back out there for Poker Run wins! We need you in order to win points for SSBC!
* Points based on:
 - # attended the Poker Run
 - # of miles (from SSBC to Poker Run event location)
 - # of boats brought to the Poker Run
5. PLEASE attend by boat or at least in person Friday night or Saturday (day or evening) OR both days!!!
6. I will have the 'book' to sign. Make sure to see me at the Poker Run and sign it!
7. Nautical coordinate and channel monitor will be shared with SSBC members within the next week.

INTRODUCING A NEW OPTION FOR REPORTING YOUR PLEASURE BOAT ARRIVAL TO CBP

Hello SVRS member,

It is our pleasure to announce that U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is launching the **CBP Reporting Offsite Arrival – Mobile (ROAM) app**, a new way for pleasure boaters to report their U.S. entry in select locations nationwide! This app provides pleasure boaters with a convenient and efficient way to report their U.S. entry from a personal device, as opposed to calling their local CBP number. ***Please note: Float plans are no longer required, and the Small Vessel Reporting System (SVRS) is being discontinued in the coming months. A notice will be posted to the SVRS website with a specific date and thereafter all travelers will be directed to utilize the CBP ROAM app. Your SVRS, Local Boater, or Registered Traveler numbers will remain in effect and can be utilized and saved within the app to expedite reporting.***

What is the CBP ROAM app?

The CBP ROAM app is a free mobile application that provides a new and faster option for pleasure boaters to report their U.S. entry to CBP. Travelers can use their personal smart device (or a tablet located at partner businesses) to satisfy reporting requirements in select areas. All travelers, regardless of nationality or citizenship, are eligible to use the CBP ROAM app.

Where can the CBP ROAM app be used?

Currently, the CBP ROAM app can be used to report U.S. entry by pleasure boat in Florida, select locations in Minnesota, and in the Great Lakes and Saint Lawrence River area between Buffalo and Ogdensburg, NY. Additional locations are being added, and travelers should contact their local port of entry to confirm whether arrival submissions via the CBP ROAM app are accepted.

Download CBP ROAM on your [Android](#) or [Apple](#) device! Detailed instructions on how to install and use the app on a personal device are attached for your reference. - Save the profile for future use



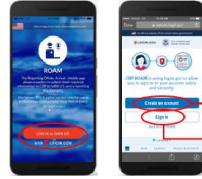
1 DOWNLOAD THE CBP ROAM APP!

- Search "CBP ROAM" in the Apple App Store or Google Play Store and download the app
- Open the CBP ROAM app and enable location services



2 SIGN INTO CBP ROAM VIA LOGIN.GOV

- Click "Log In or Sign Up" and accept the terms. The app will redirect to login.gov, where you can either create or access your existing account
- You must have a login.gov account to use the CBP ROAM app on a personal device

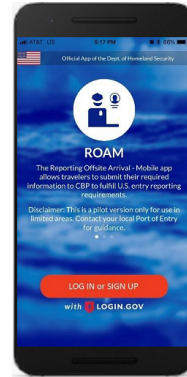


DO NOT HAVE a login.gov account? Tap "Create an account" and follow the instructions

ALREADY HAVE a login.gov account? Sign in to your account, and you will be redirected back to the ROAM app

TRIP SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Small vessel travelers can use the CBP ROAM app to report their U.S. entry to CBP.



- ✓ Accept the terms and sign into CBP ROAM using your login.gov account
- ✓ Select "Create Trip"
- ✓ Select the passengers and mode of travel (saved in profile) on trip. Click "Add Traveler" or "Add Mode of Travel" to add new profiles
- ✓ Designate a master of the vessel from the list of passenger profiles and input their phone number
- ✓ Answer all trip detail and declaration questions
- ✓ Submit the trip
- ✓ A CBP Officer will review your submission and may initiate a video chat if necessary
- ✓ A copy of the final notification will be sent to the email address provided

Streamlined reporting process with reusable traveler and mode of travel profiles using login.gov

Shorter wait times by reporting from a smart device instead of calling in

Remote inspections by CBP Officers using video chat as necessary

Having technical issues? You can still call your local CBP Port of Entry to report your arrival into the U.S.

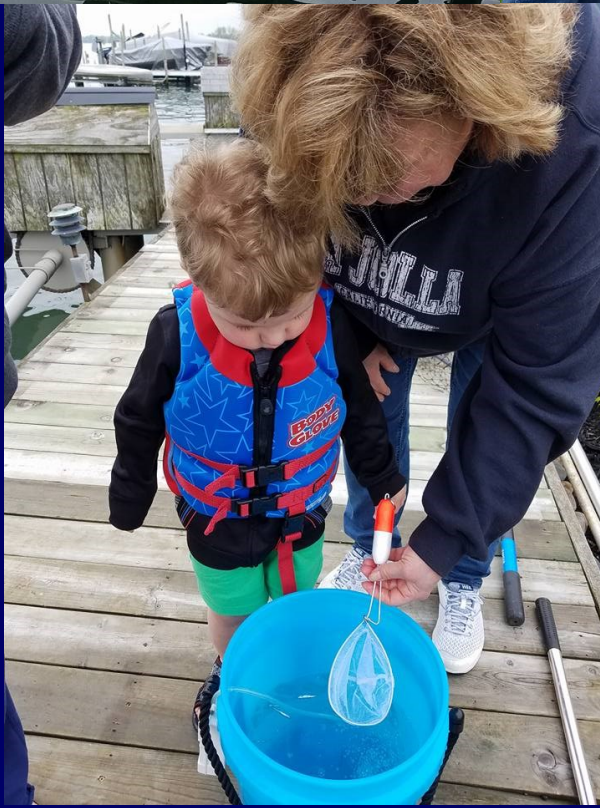
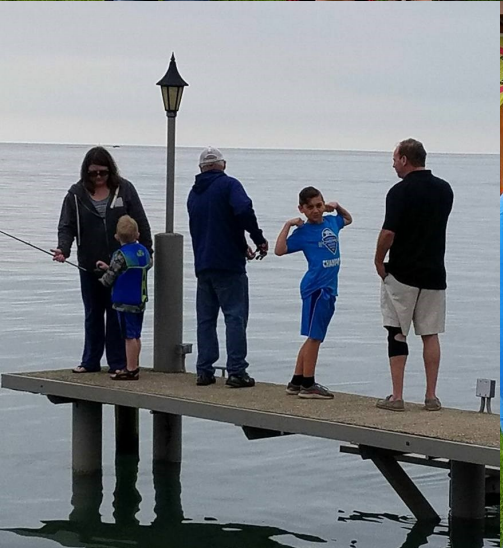
