Hello Sunseekers,

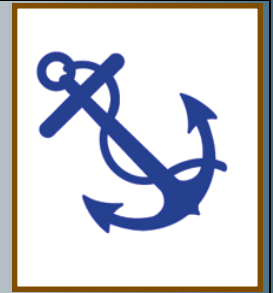
Wow, February flew by!
