June was a busy month at the club.

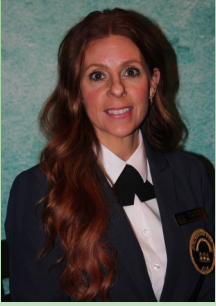
On June 6th we had Jim Jernigan playing for the fish fry to start off OOTI.

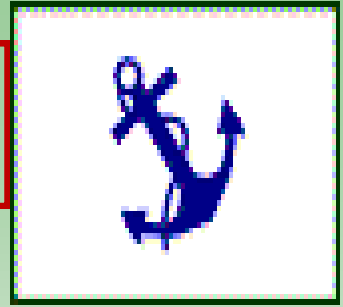
